This off-dry Riesling has exciting aromas of lemon, honey and apricots. The palate is refreshing and creamy with notes of sweet spices, lime zest and ripe nectarine. Beautifully finished with a fine mineral edge.

Barossa Valley, Australia, NV

The wine is velvety red with a nose of dark chocolate and spice, the palate is creamy with ripe plum and a sweet vanilla finish.

Champagne, France, NV

A beautiful champagne that is gold in color, with a floral nose, delicate honey notes and elegantly perceptible citrus fruit

Loose End Grenache Rose 43

Barossa Valley, Australia, 2006

It is candy pink in color and has a nose of lifted confectionery. With a palate of spicy berries and a clean, crisp finish. This wine is both playful and fun. 89 Points - Wine Spectator

Belle Vallee Pinot Gris 42

Willamette Valley, Oregon, 2006

An Oregon version of Alsatian Pinot Gris, that is clean, rich and viscous with riper more scented fruit. Melon and honey evolve in the creamy, mouth filling texture. Ends with a lingering mineral and pear finish.

Gaierhof Pinot Grigio 42

Trentino, Italy, 2007

A suggestive nose of peach, banana, and jasmine with lush flavors and straight forward acidity.

Vision Cellars Riesling 40

Santa Lucia Highlands, California, 2006

The two most important varietal elements, racy acidity and subtle flavor, are both here. The latter suggest peaches, Meyer lemons and wildflowers, with a rich undertow of stony minerals, and the finish is wonderfully bone dry.

Rheingau, Germany, 2004

This Riesling displays a nice balance of minerals, crisp acidity and a delicious, fruity sweetness.

J. Wilkes Pinot Blanc 37

Santa Barbara County - Bien Nacido, CA, 2006

This fruity wine shows South Coast Chardonnay-like flavors in the ripe mango, papaya and peach, and also showcases cool-climate acidity that makes that fruit sing on the palate. It's dry and vibrantly fresh.

Lange Twins Sauvignon Blanc 35

Lodi - Jahant Vineyard, California 2007

Opens with a lemon blossom and lime zest aroma, a light and refreshing Meyer Lemon note with undertones of honeydew melon on the palate. Its well balanced light-creamy palate, from surly aging, leads to a mellow and long lingering finish.

Napa Valley, California, 2008

Aromas of tropical fruit mixed with fresh citrus, lychee and passion fruit. Crisp, fresh and lively on the palate, with vibrant grapefruit notes, apricots and hints of tropical fruits, guava and fresh pineapple.

Lawson's Dry Hill Sauvignon Blanc 46

Marlborough, New Zealand, 2007

Unmistakably Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with trademark passion fruit and gooseberry aromas with lime and melon notes. The palate features a strong lemon/lime acidity that provides wonderful crispness and fine minerality on the finish.

Rueda, Spain, 2007

A beautiful example of the Verdejo varietal, typical of this region in Spain. Aromas of cut grass and fresh herbs are followed by crisp flavors of grapefruit and lemon peel.

Clarksburg, California, 2007

A very aromatic nose of apricots, pineapple, white rose and honeysuckle. There are notes of white peach and slate mineral on the mid-palate followed by a long finish of Kaffir lime.

Consilience Viognier 52
Santa Barbara County, California, 2006
Exhibits an intense bouquet of honeysuckle and melon. Flavors combine and give way to a pleasant union of apples and pears. Crisp minerality from partial stainless barreling provides a brisk and refreshing finish.

Edward Sellers Viognier 55
Paso Robles, California, 2007
Attractive honeyed floral aromatics are punctuated by a subtle yet refreshing acidity, reminiscent of ripe citrus fruits. A creamy, vanilla undertone is accentuated by soft quince and jasmine aromas. The wine is subtle and elegant, showing bright fruit in the mouth with a long, smooth finish hinting at apricots and mango.

Gemtree Citrine Chardonnay 36
McLaren Vale, Australia, 2006
The front palate is a luscious mouth feel of zesty limes and citrus characters. New French oak is evident in the mid to back palate yet the emphasis of this wine is in the lingering fruit power.

Charles Wiffen Chardonnay 36
Marlborough, New Zealand, 2007
This wine has aromas of fig, white nectarine and peach. Ten months in a mix of new and seasoned French Oak gives a balanced and elegant palate with a soft lingering nutty finish.

Mazzocco Stuhlmuller Chardonnay 44
Sonoma County - Alexander Valley, California, 2005
Supple and graceful with tropical flavors of guava and passion fruit weaved with toasty oak. The mid-palate is round and fleshy with butterscotch and tangerine essence and hints of rhubarb ending with crisp lime rind and a dash of honey.

Charles Creek Las Patolitas Chardonnay 54
Sonoma County, California, 2006
Aromas of pear, citrus and peach are touched by a hint of spice. Honeycrisp apple and pear flavors emerge with a hint of vanilla, toast and pie spice derived from good French Oak. The texture is smooth with a generous mouthfeel and crisp finish.

Reynolds Family Winery Chardonnay 59
Napa Valley, California, 2006
Creamy caramel to start, with a touch of ripe pear. This wine will bring to mind well balanced tropical fruits and a slight touch of tangerine that finishes with smooth caramel and mouth watering citrus.

Longoria Cuvee Diana Chardonnay 65
Santa Barbara - Santa Rita Hills, California, 2005
Aromas of pears, apples with hints of vanilla and nutmeg. It displays rich fruit flavors with not so subtle suggestions of cinnamon and brown sugar. Beautifully balanced with excellent acidity, and a long silky finish.

Carneros - Hyde Vineyard, California, 2006
Asian pear notes, minerality, spice, and bracing acidity are all tightly wound in this lively and blossom perfumed wine. The intense stony and citrus palate with a feminine temperament and perfume notes tightly grip and support the wine's acidity. All the grapes are harvested from the Hyde Vineyard, one of the most renowned vineyards in California.

Red Wines

Lane Tanner Pinot Noir 54
Santa Barbara County - Bien Nacido, California, 2006
A lovely, delicious, and balanced Pinot Noir with soft acidity and tannins that frame the perfectly ripe flavors of cherries, blackberries, black raspberries and smoky vanilla.

Joseph Swan Saralee's Vineyard Pinot Noir 58
Sonoma County - Russian River Valley, California, 2006
Pale rose in color, with aromas of fresh wild strawberry, red currant and flowers. In the mouth, it is surprisingly rich and full with flavors echoing the aromas. Refreshing acidity and very fine tannins give it excellent structure.

 Monterey - Santa Lucia Highlands, California, 2005
 Bright red berry and rose petal aromas are heightened by smoky vanilla and spice. Possesses an exceptionally broad mouth-feel, the intensity of the cool climate fruit works with crisp acidity.

- Dutton Estate Jewell Block Pinot Noir** 76
 Sonoma - Russian River Valley, California, 2006
 This Pinot packs an intense structure on both the nose and the palate. Wild strawberry, cherry and a touch of sandalwood hide behind the fruit. Mouth watering texture embodies strawberry, soft red cherry and is finished with a traditional cinnamon heart.
- Vision Cellars Gary's Vineyard Pinot Noir** 86
 Santa Lucia Highlands, California, 2007
 This is a big, voluptuous Pinot, but it possesses a delicate silkiness despite the size. In its extreme youth, the wine is all fruit and oak, with flavors of cherries, black raspberries, red licorice, cola, and mild smoky vanilla.
- Belle Vallee Grand Cuvee Pinot Noir** 90
 Willamette Valley, Oregon, 2006
 Ripe plum, black cherry, currant and black pepper aromas with hints of rose petal. Broad, velvety texture and earthy spice flavors. Lengthy well integrated oak and smoky finish. Concentrated and elegant.
- Stylo Old Vines Grenache** 32
 Calatayud, Spain, 2007
 A well-balanced mouth feel leads to aromas and flavors of fresh black fruits with a long lingering finish.
- Barrel 27 Rock And A Hard Place Grenache** 47
 Central Coast, California, 2007
 A beautiful wine with a captivating nose of sweet raspberry milk chocolate, hibiscus, and cranberry. On the palate, the wine shows notes of black tea and orange rind with a hint of vanilla. Soft and rich, with a beautiful, broad mid palate, the wine's fruit and spice notes continue to build through the long finish.
- Pope Valley Sangiovese** 40
 Napa Valley - Eakle Ranch, California, 2006
 These Sangiovese vines thrive in the warm Pope Valley sun producing rich and flavorful fruit. After 12 months in French oak barrels this Sangiovese exhibits all the complex flavors this varietal has to offer.
- Finca Anzil Tempranillo** 44
 Toro - Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2004
 Medium bodied red that is ripe but restrained, with flavors of black cherry, chocolate and toast.

 California, 2006
 This full structured wine carries a focused ripe-blackberry aroma and a light berry note on the palate. The initial richness is further enhanced with cocoa powder essence, smooth tannins, and a broad mouth feel, which lingers in a long finish.

Dry Creek Valley - Buchignani Garcia Vineyard, CA, 2004
Produced from an exceptional Dry Creek Valley vineyard that was originally planted over 114 years ago. This wine is a rich, terroir driven Zinfandel offering blackberry, enriched with briar, black pepper, and subtle sweet tobacco.

Central Coast, California, 2006
Aromas of raspberry jam and crème de cassis, sweet cherry, black plum and blood orange fruit, with rose petal, anise, vanilla and Asian spices adding layers of complexity. The mouth is round and dense, with a full mid-palate lifted by excellent acidity.
- Lane Tanner French Camp Syrah** 44
Central Coast, California, 2005
The elegance and gentility of this exciting wine screams Pinot Noir while the mouth weight and lingering fruit finish whispers Syrah. The sweet juicy blackberry fruit is highlighted in the palate with a soft black pepper and smoke finish.

Mt. Lofty Ranges, Australia, 2006

Sonoma County, California, 2006
Aromas and flavors of blueberries, black pepper and menthol herb. The tannins are refined and long. A balanced wine that fills and caresses the mouth with integrated oak and a creamy texture.

Adelaide Hills, Australia, 2005

Offers rich aromas of blueberry, ripe raspberry and black currants, interlaced with coffee, creamy oak and anise. Has a velvety palate with a seductive core of ripe berries, and hints of lavender.

Paso Robles, California, 2006

Bursting with layers of fresh fruit, this wine shows lively Grenache aromas and spicy Zinfandel character, tempered by the firm and earthy structure of Syrah.

Tudal Tractor Shed Red 37

Napa Valley, California, 2006

This is a Napa Valley blend that is as unique and fun as that old tractor on the label. Lush black fruit with a hint of oak with some herbal notes such as dried sage aromas. It has bright, sweet jammy fruit flavors with good balance.

Sangiovese/ Merlot/ Zinfandel

Allora Cielo 58

Napa Valley, California, 2003

Aromas of ripe raspberry, cherry, toasted nut and espresso. The color is bright with a body that is complex, rich and spicy with a full, round, lingering finish. The Sangiovese grapes are from the Stag's Leap District and the Cabernet grapes are estate grown. Sangiovese/ Cabernet Sauvignon/ Cabernet Franc

Woodinville Little Bear Creek 48

Columbia Valley, Washington, 2005

This blend is a combination of select barrels, inspired by the complexity of nature surrounding the Woodinville winery. The 2005 represents all five Bordeaux varietals.

Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2005

Excellent ripeness and concentration with sweet raspberry fruit, spicy notes, and a touch of French oak. Carmenere/ Cabernet Franc/ Merlot / Petit Verdot

McLaren Vale, Australia, 2006

Rich chocolate and berry flavor dominate the front palate with juicy fruits bound together with an abundance of acid and tannin. The petit verdot is providing the framework of tannin and aromatics, the merlot the mid palate juiciness, the cabernet structure and the cabernet franc the perfume.
